

# MISS SHELBY COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT

## Rules for Eligibility:

1. Contestants must be single, never married, never had a marriage annulled, and never had any children.
2. Contestant must have reached her 16th birthday by October 31, 2019 and cannot have reached her 22nd birthday by October 31, 2019.
3. Contestant must be a resident of Kentucky – **open to all Kentucky counties.**
4. Contestant may have participated before but must not have been named Miss Shelby County Fair in previous participation, must not have been crowned Miss Kentucky County Fair, and must not currently hold a Miss title at another member fair for 2019 season.
5. Contestants will appear in Interview Attire (Business dress, pantsuit, etc.) for 5-minute interview at Horse Show Office Interview Time: 4:30PM \* Arrival Time – 4:15PM – **Come ready!**
6. Contestants will appear on stage THREE times at Bradley Barn. Competition: 6:00PM \* Arrival Time – 5:45PM
  - a. Opening number – One-piece pageant swimsuit with choice of sarong
  - b. Swimwear - One piece pageant swim suit
  - c. Formal wear – Floor length formal gown, age appropriate
7. Registration fee of \$100 **payable to Shelby County A&M Association**; registration form; copy of birth certificate and wallet size headshot/photo to be turned in at the informational meeting or mailed to the address listed. Registration is non-refundable. Participation is by Pre-Registration ONLY!
8. Contestants will be judged from the standpoint of beauty, poise and personality.
9. Miss Congeniality will be selected from all contestants and voted on by peers and will receive a gift from the pageant committee.
10. There will be a People's Choice/Fan Favorite winner chosen by the crowd, during the stage competition. Votes are \$1 each and can be turned in at the designated space during the pageant. Miss Fan Favorite will receive a sash and crown.
11. From the contestants, five finalists will be selected by top scores from all legs of competition. A first runner up and winner will be selected by the judges from these finalists.
12. The winner will reign at Shelby County Fair and must compete at the Miss Kentucky County Fair Pageant in January 2020 and will be expected to participate in other community-related activities including Shelby County Fair Horse Show June 17-22, 2019 and Shelby County Christmas Parade, Little Miss and Mister Pageant at Kentucky State Fair and Kentucky State Fair Opening Day Ceremonies.
13. If the winner is unable to complete her reign/responsibilities her title shall be removed and reappointed to the first-runner up for the remainder of the term.
14. The winner will receive crown, sash, flowers and \$250 from the Shelby County A&M Association, and two night hotel reimbursement for state competition (hotel only, up to \$300, no other fees, room service, etc.)
