## **STOCK TRACTOR PULL RULES**

1. Pull is open to any tractor that is in as run in field condition and meets the following conditions.
2. Each tractor is to look standard for it's year and model in appearance. All major factory sheet metal is required, and must comply with make and model. Tractors that have been stripped of internal parts such as

- PTO shafts and hydraulics will not be allowed.
3. Block, head, crankcase, frame, transmission, rear end and fuel system must comply with make and model of tractor. All parts must be factory stock, original equipment replacement or a suitable aftermarket replacement. Parts such as M&W turbochargers and oil pans are allowed but must be the ones designed for the model of tractor they are in use on. No back substituting of engine parts from larger model tractors to smaller model tractors will be allowed.
4. Stock fuel only. No alcohol or nitros. No propane assists.
5. Maximum drawbar height is 20 inches from ground. Minimum length will be 20 inches from point of hook to the center of the rear axle. Hitching device must be horizontal to the ground and stationary in all directions. No hooking over the drawbar support height.
6. No Cut Tires!
7. Any loss of ballast, fluid or parts other than from internal breakage will be grounds for disqualification while in motion.
8. NO driver under 15 years of age. Any driver under 18 must have written consent of parent or legal guardian.
9. No weight bracket is to exceed over one foot in front of the furthestmost point of the tractor. No weights are to extend rearward beyond the rear wheels
10. All drivers must adhere to the flag person at all times or they will be disqualified.
11. Drivers must weigh in on tractor. All tractors must weigh at or under the weight for the class at weigh in.
12. When a tractor is in the lead position it must weigh out
13. Each tractor is allowed two hooks
14. East contestant is allowed two starts in the first 25 feet
15. Driver must remain seated with one hand on steering wheel at all times. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times or the contestant will be disqualified.
16. If tractor or sled crosses boundary line then the driver will be disqualified
17. No jerk start of sled
18. Only tractor and driver allowed within the white lines on track anyone else on track is grounds for disqualification
29. Tractor has three minutes after being called to be hooked or will be disqualified
20. No rider on tractor at any time
21. No entries accepted after start of class
22. Any driver protesting can only protest a tractor in their class, and the protestor's tractor must be proven to be legal first. Tractors that have been protested by a Committee Member must be checked by the committee before it is allowed to pull again. If the tractor is found to not meet the criteria for that class it will be disqualified from that class and all other classes that night.
23. Tractors could be subjected to dyno testing any tractor found to be more than 20% over on horsepower could be disqualified
24. Judges decision(s) are FINAL.
25. Hook point must be clear and visible open 2 feet above hook point and 1 foot from sides of hook point
26. No Twisted Clevises
27. Drawbar must be stationary in all directions

## **FIELD FARM STOCK ADDITIONAL RULES**

1. 2800 RPM Max
2. Standard Pump and block for make and model of tractor
3. 20.8 38 max tire size, no cut or polished tires

## **HOT FARM STOCK ADDITIONAL RULES**

1. 3000 RPM Max
2. Tractor is to look original in appearance, "M&W Parts OK – turbos & oil pans
3. Steel flywheel, wheelie bars, air shutoff with connection to hook sled
4. Standard pump and block for make and model of tractor
5. Turbo has 2.5" of inlet and 3.0" exhaust max
6. 20.8 38 max tire size, no cut or polished tires
